Training objectives

Development of human capacity and infrastructure for clinical and biomedical research in collaboration with Medical Schools, Universities and other Health related Institution is one of the mandates of the institute. In keeping with this mandate, the institute has identified arrears of immediate needs which require human capacity development to enhance and strengthen health research in the country.
